- 9. welcome and incorporate new members into the community?
- 10. foster a sense of belonging and mutual care as a community?
- 11. focus on mission in terms of looking beyond our own needs and interests?
- 12. allocate our funds in support of our mission?
- 13. exercise our leadership roles?
- 14. empower members for service?
- 15. utilize the gifts, skills, and resources of the community?
- 16. use our facilities to support our needs, our mission, and our strategic goals?
- 17. create and maintain a warm and friendly environment throughout our facilities?
