Adult Faith Formation and the Liturgy

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults has heightened awareness of the intrinsic link between adult faith formation and the liturgy. In paragraph 75, we read that the catechesis of candidates should be "accommodated to the liturgical year, and solidly supported by celebrations of the word."

Both the *General Directory for Catechesis* and the *National Directory for Catechesis* call for the RCIA to serve as the "model" or "inspiration" for all catechesis. For this reason, the North American Forum on the Catechumenate and the National Conference on Catechetical Leadership hosted a national symposium earlier this decade to explore ways in which the RCIA could serve as the inspiration for catechetical ministry. Insights from the symposium are presented in *An Apprenticeship in the Christian Life: Exploring the Baptismal Catechumenate as Inspiration for All Catechesis* by Marie Kordes and Loyes Spayd. Many adult faith formation leaders have sought to base some or all of their programs on the liturgical year. Publishers and organizations have responded to this need by creating a variety of resources.
